This is about creating conditions to gather energy, to soften, and to return to yourself — recognising that comfort is part of the cycle, and that every season of our life has its purpose.

In this lesson, we'll create a layered art journal spread centred on a sleeping face and the half remembered dream rising above her, a quiet portrait of hibernation. This is about honouring the season's invitation to rest, to dream, and to trust whatever surfaces in that stillness.

My Discussion with Francoise Gilot

Growing up, I fell in love with a painting in my Grandma Jeanne's dining room. Her home was filled with original art, and it became a deeply inspiring place for me. Years later, after Kelly and I bought our home, my grandmother invited me to choose a piece from her collection. The artwork I had always admired turned out to be by Françoise Gilot, and she also gifted me Gilot's book, *Life With Picasso*.

My admiration for Gilot has only grown over the years. While her artwork inspires me greatly, it is her creative spirit that moves me most. Through every season of life, she continued to create, adapting her mediums but never abandoning her calling. She painted almost until her passing at 101. In this lesson, we'll draw inspiration from Gilot's expressive portraits using charcoal, ink, graphite, white oil pastel, acrylic paint, a clear blending stick, and a gelli plate.

Layered & Tactile: Inspired Textures for Your Art Journal

In this lesson, we're creating a richly layered art journal spread inspired by the comforting textures of woven fabrics, natural fibres, handmade papers, and beautifully tactile surfaces. Think of the feeling of chunky textures, layered materials, soft fibres, and weathered cloth translated into mixed media. Using light modelling paste, painted Kozo paper, and fabric, we'll explore three simple ways to build texture that feels dimensional, expressive, and full of depth. Each material brings its own unique quality to the page — the modelling paste creates sculptural raised surfaces, the Kozo paper adds delicate fibres and movement, while fabric introduces soft organic texture and layered visual interest. This lesson is an invitation to slow down and respond intuitively to texture, allowing your surfaces to become rich, tactile, and full of life. Rather than simply decorating the page, we'll be building a mixed media surface that feels layered, organic, and expressive.

Using graphite, Pan Pastels, gouache, and coloured pencil, we'll explore smoky cityscapes, expressive animal characters, and playful compositions that can be mixed together in different ways.

The final spreads will feel dreamy and atmospheric, contrasted with bright, punchy characters: somewhere between an illustration and a weird dream.

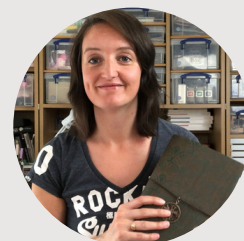
