Patterns of Interpersonal Conflict

This is the second course in Facilitated Solutions' *FOUNDATIONS OF CONFLICT RESOLUTION* training program.

While every interpersonal conflict can seem unique, there are several common patterns and dynamics. This course will explore some common ways that conflict develops and escalates so that you can better recognize the pattern and be better equipped to make informed choices.

Key Objectives and Outcomes:

- To understand how conflict inevitably emerges in interpersonal relationships
- To differentiate between early “pinch” moments and escalated “crunch” events
- To gain insight on the positive potential of pinch moments
- To understand the gift of open conflict

Training Modules:
