HOW TO USE AN ANCHOR CHART

An **anchor chart** is a visual tool that “anchors” student learning. It stays posted in the classroom so students can refer to it during lessons, independent work, and small-group instruction.

How to Use It:

- 1. Teach it first.**
Introduce the chart during your lesson. Walk students through each part and model how to use it.
- 2. Think out loud.**
Show how the chart helps you solve a problem, answer a question, or complete a task.
- 3. Post it where students can see it.**
Keep it at eye level and near the learning area (reading corner, writing station, etc.).
- 4. Refer to it often.**
Say things like:
“Check the anchor chart.”
“Which step comes next?”
- 5. Use it for support, not answers.**
The chart guides thinking—it doesn’t give away the work.
- 6. Let students use it independently.**
Students should rely on the chart before asking for help. That’s how independence grows.

Why Anchor Charts Work:

They provide structure, reduce confusion, support memory, and keep learning consistent—especially for visual learners, multilingual students, and students with learning needs.

Bottom line:

If the chart isn’t being used, it’s just wall décor.

If it *is* being used, it’s a silent co-teacher.

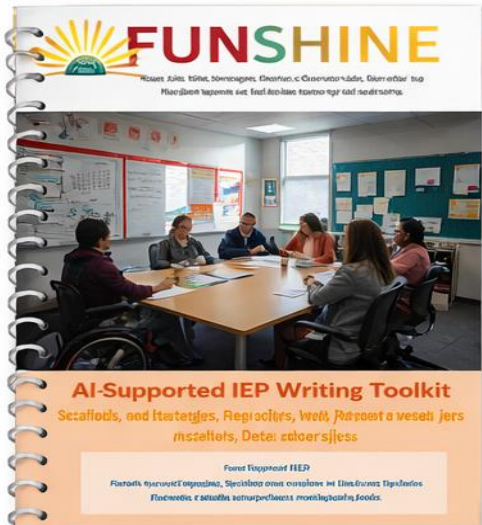

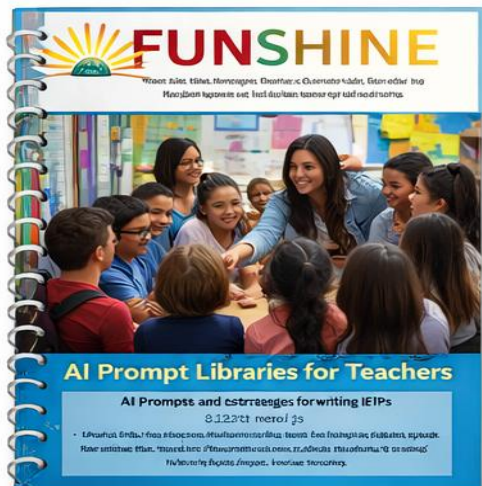

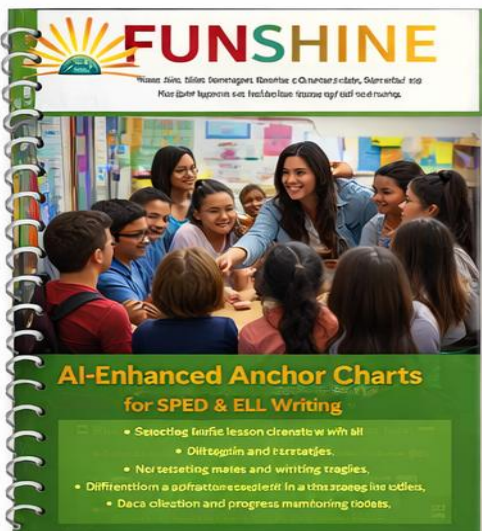
