- Four-year degree
- 36 months leading projects
- 35 hours of project management education/training or CAPM® Certification

OR

- A high school diploma or an associate's degree (or global equivalent)
- 60 months leading projects
- 35 hours of project management education/training or CAPM® Certification

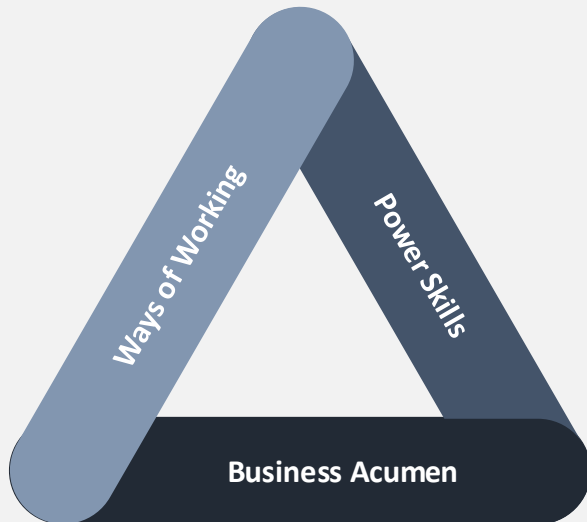
Examination Content Outline - ECO

About the PMP Exam



Aligned with ECO and PMI's Talent Triangle®, the PMP exam is structured around three key domains:

- **People (Power Skills)**
Leadership, team performance, stakeholder engagement
- **Process (Ways of Working)**
Technical project management across delivery approaches (predictive and agile methods and hybrid applications)
- **Business Environment (Business Acumen)**
Strategy, value delivery, and organizational impact

Balances leadership, technical and strategic skills

About the PMP Exam

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Exam Format

- 180 questions
- 240 minutes (4 hours)

Question Style

- Scenario-based and situational questions
- More interactive item types
- Focused on analysis and decision-making
- Greater emphasis on adaptive project dynamics

- Modern project management practices

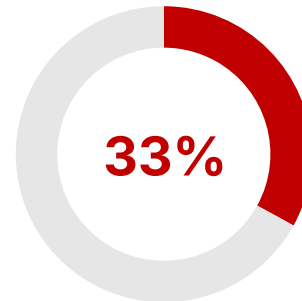

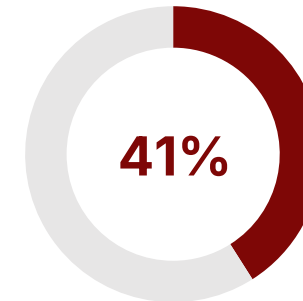

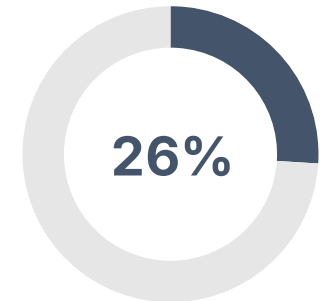
