



Prayer prompts are meant to serve as a springboard to your prayers. Use them to help focus your thoughts and give direction to your prayers as you meditate on the theme of remembering what God has done.

* Father, when I read in Your word how you have always remembered Your people and intended good for them, I am encouraged that You will remember me as well. Especially in the hard times, remind me to take comfort in the fact that You are always working behind the scenes for my benefit.

* God, help me to realize that Your timing is perfect and when scripture says that You remember Your people, it does not mean that you had forgotten them in the past. I know you are likewise constantly loving and providing for me, even when I feel forgotten. Please forgive me for my doubt and give me courage to know You will move on my behalf at the perfect time.

* Lord, please remind me to take inventory of my life and tear down any other gods I have made to worship. I want my allegiance to be to You alone because You are the only true God. Redirect me when I need to lift my eyes to You instead of focusing on the physical world around me.

* Father, I want to remember You more than just daily; I want to remember You in every moment. Please guide me to see You often in my everyday life, as I actively look for You in Your word and ask for Your help as I make decisions. Prompt me to talk to You in prayer.

* Lord God, show me the dangers of forgetting You and Your word, both seeing the warnings You have left for us in scripture and in the lives of people I know currently (including myself!). So much evil and corruption comes from not actively remembering and keeping our focus on You. Help me to bravely and lovingly encourage others to remember You and Your many wonderful works as well.

* God, search my heart and show me where I've drifted from my first love. Remind me of the zeal and focus I once had. Lead me to repentance and renewal.

* LORD, I want to seek Your presence continually! I want to remember and ponder Your many miracles and judgments, just as the children of Israel did. Keep me in Your Word and thinking about Your covenants and promises that you gave to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. Remind me that I have become a part of spiritual Israel when I was joined with Jesus Christ in baptism.

* Lord, when I am struggling to sleep or my mind feels overwhelmed, help me to remember Your steadfast love and faithfulness. Let my thoughts turn toward You instead of worry. Remind me that with You I am safe, cared for, and never forgotten.

* Father, teach my heart not to forget the countless ways You've shown mercy and grace. You have forgiven me. You have healed me. And You have redeemed at such a great cost. Help me never to take Your blessings for granted.

* God, I love the stories of Your power throughout Your word. You have split seas, healed bodies and hearts, and even raised the dead. You are still the same today. Strengthen my faith as I remember how You've moved in my own life. Help me to always trust in Your power to work in my life according to Your perfect wisdom.

* Lord, I am so thankful that You never forget Your promises. Even when my faith is weak, You remain faithful. Remind me that Your covenant love is unbreakable.

* Father, help me to live each day with gratitude towards You. You have given me breath and created me for a purpose. Help me not drift through life chasing useless temporary things. Teach me to always seek You and Your kingdom first in my life.

* Lord, I know that before You rescued me, I was utterly lost and without hope. Thank You for bringing me near to You through the blood of Jesus. Help me to be humble, compassionate, and deeply aware of Your grace and mercy toward me and others.
