



Prayer prompts are meant to serve as a springboard to your prayers. Use them to help focus your thoughts and give direction to your prayers as you meditate on the theme of being victorious in God.

* Lord, when I face circumstances that feel overwhelming, remind me that I do not have to face them alone. You go before me, just as You did for Israel. You will fight for me and help me through. Help me to set aside my fear and have courage, because You are always with me.

* God, I confess that I rely too much on worldly resources for security. Teach me to fully put my trust in You, because You are the One who gives victory and You never fail.

* Lord, when the world around me feels unstable and full of evil, remind me that You are my refuge and my strength. You are a present help in times of trouble, not a distant, uncaring God. With You at my side, I can face the storms without fear.

* God, I know that my human strength and wisdom are not enough, but sometimes I rely too much on myself. Remind me that salvation comes from You alone and help me to lean on You always.

* Lord, Your Son warns me that trials will come, but He also promised His peace. I am so thankful that You have already overcome the world, so I can have confidence to face those trials with courage. Let my heart take comfort in Your victory, no matter what tribulations may come.

* God, I'm so comforted to know that no hardship, no persecution, or no suffering can separate me from Your love. In Christ, I am not just a survivor, I am more than a conqueror. Give me the faith to walk in that truth and hold fast to Your love.

* Lord, it is so painful to lose a loved one. But because of Jesus' resurrection, death has lost its ultimate sting. Through Him, we now have the victory - the hope of eternal life with You and peace knowing that the faithful will be raised up again.

* God, thank you for inspiring Paul to record Your response to his request to remove his thorn in the flesh. I am so comforted to know that Your grace is sufficient for me, too, and that Your power is made perfect in weakness. Teach me to embrace my human frailties, because when I am weak, then I am truly strong in You.

* Lord, help me to be diligent to put on the spiritual armor You have given me. I am thankful for the belt of truth, the shield of faith, the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit. Prepare me to stand against the devil and his schemes with courage and endurance and be victorious over temptation.

* God, help me lay aside every weight and sin that tries to slow me down. Give me the strength to press on, fixing my eyes on Jesus who is the author and finisher of my faith. Thank you for His victory on the cross that secures my eternal salvation if I remain faithful.
