- Shots can be categorized into going-away, incoming, quartering, and crossing targets.
- Each requires different degrees of gun movement and speed.
- As the target's speed and distance increases, so do the need to work harder to plan and execute your shot – you must have a specific plan for each target.
- Different targets require different strategies.
- Specialty targets and presentations such as chandelles and battues demand greater gun speed and the ability to move away from a straight flight line.
