$$\frac{2}{3} \bigcirc \frac{1}{3}$$

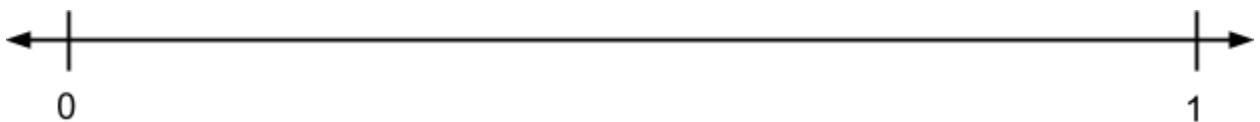
$$\frac{3}{3} \bigcirc \frac{2}{3}$$

$$\frac{4}{6} \bigcirc \frac{6}{6}$$

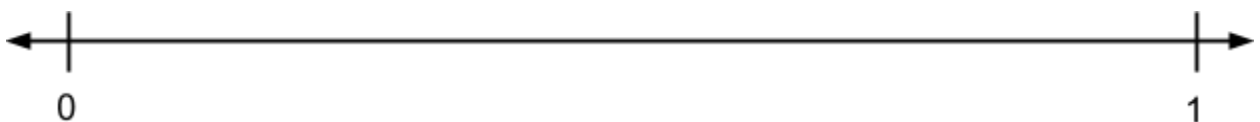
$$\frac{2}{6} \bigcirc \frac{5}{6}$$

$$\frac{4}{4} \bigcirc \frac{1}{4}$$

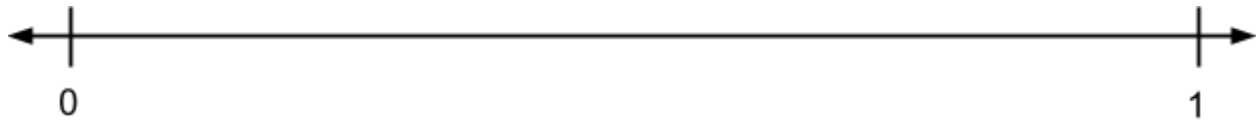
