



What are prayer prompts? If you're new to prayer prompts, they are thoughts meant to serve as a springboard to your prayers. Use them to help focus your thoughts and give direction to your prayers as you meditate on the theme of being unshaken in God.

* Lord, remind me of the battles You have already brought me through safely. Help me to remember that You are with me when I face my own giants. I want to face challenges with the same confidence David had, trusting that You will deliver me.

* God, give me the courage to walk with obedience even when it feels costly. Help me to be more like Esther, who risked her life for her people in faith. Help me to have bold faith that values Your purpose and Your will above my own comfort or security.

* Father, teach me to worship You in every season, whether in gain or loss, like Job. In the middle of unthinkable tragedy, he worshiped You. Strengthen me to remain faithful when life feels unfair. Help me to trust Your goodness even when I do not understand Your ways.

* Lord, fill my heart with a deep love for Your Word. I want my faith to be rooted in truth and not in unreliable feelings. Like David, I want Your Word to be my delight, my meditation, and my source of strength when I need to speak boldly to others.

* God, give me strength to stand firm in holiness, even when the world pressures me to compromise. Like Daniel and his friends, help me to resolve in my heart to honor You first, and trust that obedience to You is always the right choice.

* Lord, help me keep my eyes fixed on You so that when You call me out of my comfort zone, I will step forward without fear. I know that if I stay focused on You, I can overcome any storm in my life.

* God, I want to have faith that acts boldly like the friends who carried the paralyzed man to Jesus. Give me persistence and faith that is not afraid to take risks in order to help others.

* Lord, I am so amazed by the boldness with which Peter preached on the Day of Pentecost. Help me to speak Your Word without fear, even in the face of opposition.

* Father, please teach me to walk in obedience even when I cannot see the outcome. Abraham stepped out in faith without knowing where You were leading. Strengthen my trust that Your promises will be fulfilled and that I can boldly follow where You lead me.

* Lord, anchor my confidence in You alone. Remind me that I can say with bold assurance, "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear." Teach me to trust in Your unchanging character when the world is uncertain. Help me to always remember that Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.
