Passive Voice (review)

Subject: unknown

Focus on: action

He cleaned the bedroom.

The bedroom was cleaned.



Passive Voice (review)

PRESENT TENSES	FORMULA	EXAMPLE
Present Simple	Am / is / are + <u>past participle</u>	He is <u>paid</u> on the last day of the month.
Present continuous	Am / is / are + <u>being</u> + <u>past participle</u>	We are being <u>given</u> an extra day's pay.
Present perfect	Have / has + <u>been</u> + <u>past participle</u>	I have been <u>asked</u> to come and see you.
PAST TENSES	FORMULA	EXAMPLE
Past Simple	Was / were + <u>past participle</u>	He was <u>expected</u> to pass the road test.
Past continuous	Was / were + <u>being</u> + <u>past participle</u>	We were being <u>taken</u> on a tour.
Past perfect	Had + <u>been</u> + <u>past participle</u>	The room hadn't been <u>cleaned</u> before we arrived.
FUTURE TENSES	FORMULA	EXAMPLE
Future Simple (will)	Will + <u>be</u> + <u>past participle</u>	He will be <u>invited</u> via email.
Future Simple (going to)	Am / is / are + <u>going to</u> + <u>be</u> + <u>past participle</u>	We are going to be <u>invited</u> via email.

Passive Voice (want)

Subject + **want** + objective + past participle

Verb	Passive Voice Sentence
Trim	I want the sides trimmed.
Gone	I want all my greys gone.
Shifted	I want all the (stock / furniture / things...) shifted.

Passive Voice (like)

Subject + **like** + objective + past participle

Verb	Passive Voice Sentence
Brewed	I like my coffee / tea brewed fresh.
Cooked	I like food cooked from scratch.
Paid	I like my bills paid in full each and every month.

When do we use Passive Voice (want) (audio X3)

Subject + want + objective + past participle

1. I want the sleeved shortened.
2. I want the TV turned down all the way.
3. She wants the letters directed to her new address.
4. We wanted our broadband upgraded ages ago.
5. He's wanted the carpet replaced for some time.
6. I've been wanting the car fixed for months.
7. They will want the food delivered piping hot.
8. I want the fruit washed thoroughly.
9. I don't want your car parked in front of my driveway.
10. I want the PC reserved for collection tomorrow morning.

When do we use Passive Voice (like) (audio X3)

Subject + like + objective + past participle

1. I like my bed made a certain way.
2. We like our receipts emailed to us.
3. He likes the bedside lamp left on at night.
4. I like my fruit and veg bought from the local farm.
5. We don't like plans postponed without prior warning.
6. I don't like all these marketing texts send to my phone.
7. She likes her phone upgraded every year.
8. I like my nails filed and shaped regularly.
9. I don't like my beard shaven too close.
10. I don't like shoes bought online. It's too risky.
